

VOLUNTEER VACANCIES

The Town of Berthoud has the following openings on volunteer boards and commissions:

PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION: Meets the second and fourth Thursday evenings of the month. Three vacancies for residents within the Town limits. Terms are four (4) years.

PARKS & OPEN SPACE BOARD: Meeting day and time to be determined. Four (4) vacancies for residents within the town limits. Terms are four (4) years.

TREE BOARD: The Board meets on the 3rd Monday evening of each month. There are three (3) vacancies, with a majority of the vacancies to be filled by residents within the Town limits. Terms are for three (3) years.

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE: The Committee meets every other month, usually the second Wednesday morning. There is one (1) vacancy for a resident within the town limits. Terms are for three (3) years.

UTILITY ADVISORY BOARD: Meeting day and time to be determined. There are five (5) vacancies – at least three (3) to be filled by residents within the town limits and no more than two (2) to be filled by residents outside the town limits. Terms are for three (3) years.

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION: The Commission meets the fourth Wednesday of each month. There are three (3) vacancies – at least one (1) to be filled by residents within the town limits and no more than two (2) to be filled by residents outside the town limits. Terms are for three (3) years.
