

PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS, in celebration of Berthoud's Agricultural Heritage, and for the many contributions made by rural members of our community, and

- WHEREAS, Mr Markham's contributions in establishing curriculum to facilitate an effective educational and training program through FFA and our local schools encourage the longevity of this heritage, and
