### ORDINANCE No. 261

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE VOTE OF THE TAXPAYING ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD THE QUESTION OF CREATING AN INDEBTEDNESS OF AND THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD IN THE SUM OF EIGHTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING AND ENLARGING THE WATER WORKS SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. That a special election is hereby ordered and called to be held in the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, on the 13th day of January, 1959, beginning at the hour of 7 o'clock in the forenoon and closing at the hour of 7 o'clock in the evening of said day, for the purpose of taking a vote of the taxpaying electors of said Town, upon the following question, which is hereby submitted to the said voters for their determination at said election:

Shall the taxpaying electors of the Town of Berthoud approve the improvement and enlargement of the present water works system of the said Town, funds for which are to be raised by the issue of negotiable couponsbonds of said Town in an amount not exceeding Eighty-five (\$85,000.00) Thousand Dollars.

Section 2. All persons, who at the time of said election are taxpaying electors of the Town of Berthoud under the law, shall be entitled to vote at said election, and all of said qualified voters who approve the improvement and enlargement of said water works system shall vote by ballot whereon is printed the words:

"FOR THE IMPROVEMENT AND ENLARGEMENT OF THE TOWN WATER WORKS SYSTEM"

and those opposed thereto shall vote by ballot whereon is printed the words:

"AGAINST THE IMPROVEMENT AND ENLARGEMENT OF THE TOWN WATER WORKS SYSTEM".


Section 3. The Town Hall in the Town of Berthoud shall be and is hereby appointed as the polling place of said election.

Section 4. Notice of the said election and the conduct of said election shall be as prescribed in Chapter 49, Article 22, Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended.
