### ORDINANCE NO. 252

Relating to the Transfer of a Certain Allotment of Water by The Northern Colorado Water Conservancy District from a Class D Attotment to a Class B. Allotment.

WHEREAS a Class D allotment of 20 acre feet of water was allotted to the following lands by an order of The Northern Colorado Water Conservancy District recorded in Book 699 at Page 444 of the land records of Larimer County, Colorado:

Part of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section twenty-three (23), Township four (4) North, Range sixty-nine West (69) of the 6th P.M. as more specifically described in deed recorded in Book 228, Page 484, Larimer County records; also, beginning 400 feet south and 522.5 feet east of the northwest corner of the northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section twenty-three (23); thence East 205 feet; thence South 260 feet; thence West 205 feet; thence North 260 feet to the point of beginning.

AND WHEREAS the said lands now belong to the Town of Berthoud, Colorado;

AND WHEREAS the said Town is not eligible for a Class D Allotment under the statute in such cases made and provided;


NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado:

Section 1. That the Town elects to petition the Board of Directors of the Northern Colorado Water Conservancy District for an order transferring the said Class D allotment to the said Town as a Class B allotment, subject to all of the terms and conditions of the existing Class B allotment of said Town.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Town Clerk of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, be, and they are hereby, authorized and directed to petition the said Board of Directors for the said order of transfer.
