### ORDINANCE NO. 245

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 22, AS AMENDED, TO LICENSE PIN BALL MACHINES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud:

Section 1. That Articles 3, 5 and 6 of Ordinance No. 22, as amended, of the Town of Berthoud, be, and they are hereby, repealed.

Section 2. That Article 2 of said Ordinance No. 22 be amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to carry on the business of keeper for gain or hire, within the Town of Berthoud, of any billiard table, pocket billiard table, or any table upon which games are played with balls, or bowling alley, or pin ball machine, or photo electric machine, or other similar coin-operated music or amusement device, without a license therefor first had and obtained according to the provisions of this Ordinance. Such licenses shall expire on December 31st next, after the date of issue, and no rebate of the license or part thereof shall be made in any event.

Section. 2 The following fees shall be paid for licenses issued in accordance with the foregoing section:

For each establishment operating one or more billiard tables, pocket billiard tables, or other tables upon which games are played with balls, eight dollars and seventy-five cents (\$8.75) per calendar quarter or fraction thereof;

For each bowling alley, ten dollars (\$10.00) per year or fraction thereof;

For each pin ball machine, photo electric machine or other similar coin-operated music or amusement device, ten dollars (\$10.00) per year or fraction thereof.

Section 3. Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of this Article shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined not less than three dollars (\$3.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each day of such violation, and shall have his license revoked."

Section 3. That an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance is declared to be necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall go into effect immediately after its passage and final publication.
