

ORDINANCE NO. 357

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF 1971 BUDGET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. In the year 1971 the Town Board of Trustees approved a Street Improvement District, and the cost thereof was more than the Town Board anticipated due to new development within the Town. As a result the Town was constrained to install six hundred fifty feet of six inch water main not foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 1971 budget. Furthermore, as a result of the increased growth of the Town, the Board of Trustees was compelled to employ one additional patrolman for the Police Department and additional help in the Administration Department.

These additional expenditures caused the budget of the Street Department to be exceeded by \$ 100.00, the budget of the Water Department to be exceeded by \$ 300.00, the budget of the Police Department to be exceeded by \$ 3400.00, and the budget of the Administration Department exceeded by \$ 2300.00.

Section 2. Under the provisions of CRS 1963 88-1-12 and 88-1-15, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud hereby authorize the expenditure of funds in excess of the 1971 budget in the amount of \$ 8000.00. Wherefore the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud hereby authorizes the expenditure from the Contingency Fund appropriated in the 1971 budget of \$ 8000.00.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees herewith determines and designates that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its final passage and adoption and publication.

The above ordinance was passed on first reading and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, at its regular meeting held Tuesday, December 14, 1971, with _____ trustees voting for the adoption of this ordinance and _____ trustees voting against the adoption of this ordinance. That said vote therefore meets the requirement that the ordinance be adopted by two-thirds vote of the Board of Trustees.

The Town Clerk is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to be filed with the State Division of Local Government and published in full one time in a newspaper having general circulation within the limits of the Town of Berthoud.


