

ORDINANCE NO. 355

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE VACATING OF A PORTION OF MASSACHUSETTS AVENUE IN THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. Purpose:

The purpose of this Ordinance is to coordinate and adjust the development of the municipality in accordance with present and future needs and promote the order, convenience, prosperity and general welfare.

Section 2.

All that portion of Massachusetts Avenue located East of the Colorado and Southern Railroad in the Town of Berthoud, Larimer County, Colorado, heretofore, dedicated under laws made and provided, is hereby vacated and the prior appropriation of the land for the aforesaid part of Massachusetts Avenue is terminated.

Section 3. Effective Date:


The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage, adoption and publication.
