

ORDINANCE NO. 319

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD PLANNING
COMMISSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH C.R.S. 1963 CHAPTER 139-59

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. There is hereby established the Town of Berthoud Planning Commission consisting of five (5) members. Said membership shall be determined and appointed in the following manner: One member of said Commission to be the Mayor; one member to be a Trustee selected by the Mayor; and, three members to be appointed by the Town Board. All members of the Commission shall be bona fide residents of the municipality for the entire tenure of their membership on the Planning Commission.

The terms of the members shall be as follows: For those members of the Commission also serving as Trustees, their term on the Planning Commission shall run coincidental with their terms on the Board of Trustees. For the members selected by the Town Board, they shall serve for a term of six years with the initial appointment being one of such members for a term of two years, one of such members for a term of four years and one of such members for a term of six years.

Section 2. Any Ordinance of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 3. The Town Board herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and whereas in the opinion of the Town Board an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon adoption.
