

ORDINANCE NO. 302

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO POLICE DEPARTMENT UNIFORMS
AND POLICEMEN'S PENSION FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF
BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. Every police officer shall furnish and wear
at all times while on duty, a uniform of the type and quality
prescribed by the council.

Section 2.

(a) The Town Clerk of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado
hereby is authorized and directed to pay from the general fund
of the Town of Berthoud into the Policemen's Pension Fund of the
Town of Berthoud such sum monthly as shall be computed by applying
to the monthly salaries of the total Police Department the then
prevailing percentage of a private employer's contribution under
the Federal Insurance Contributions Act.

(b) The members of the Police Department of the Town of
Berthoud shall, from their respective monthly salaries, contribute
into the Policemen's Pension Fund of the Town of Berthoud, the
same percentage monthly of their respective monthly salaries as
they would be otherwise obliged to pay if they were subject to
the provisions of the Federal Insurance Contributions Act, so that
the monthly contribution of the Police Department as a whole shall
match the monthly contribution of the Town of Berthoud. In order
to effect such contribution, the Town Clerk of the Town of Berthoud
be and hereby is authorized and directed to deduct the appropriate
amounts as are hereinabove described in this Section from the
respective monthly salaries of the members of the Berthoud Police
Department and deposit the same in the Policemen's Pension Fund
of the Town of Berthoud.

(c) The provisions for Policemen's Pension benefits of
the Town of Berthoud shall be as are set forth in Chapter 139,
Article 49, CRS 1953 as amended.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its final passage, adoption and publication.
