

ORDINANCE NO. 435

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 3, SUBSECTION 3.2-1 RELATING TO OATH OF OFFICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1:

That Chapter 3, Subsection 3.2-1 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.2-1 - OATH. Before entering upon the duties of the office, the Clerk shall take an oath of office promising to faithfully discharge her duties as Town Clerk and that when she shall vacate such office she will turn over and deliver to her successor all moneys, books, papers, property or thing belonging to the Town of Berthoud and remaining in her charge as such Clerk.

Section 2:

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its meeting held this 26th day of April, 1977.
