

ORDINANCE NO. 430

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXPENDITURE OF DONATIONS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud has determined that money be received and appropriated for the following public purposes of the Town of Berthoud: Participation in the celebration of the Centennial Anniversary of the State of Colorado; Landscaping the Greenlawn Cemetery; and, Preservation of an historic stone building which is to be converted into a Museum.

Section 2.

(a) The Town of Berthoud accept a donation of \$750.00 from the Colorado Centennial Commission and expend said sum for the Town's celebration of the Colorado Centennial.

(b) The Town of Berthoud accept donations of \$6,966.14 from concerned citizens and expend \$5,366.14 to tile the open irrigation ditch which traverses the east side of the Greenlawn Cemetery, and expend \$1,600.00 to purchase and plant trees at said cemetery.

(c) The Town of Berthoud accept donations of \$7,000.00 from concerned citizens and matching funds of \$7,000.00 from Larimer County and expend said sum of \$14,000.00 to purchase Lots 3 and 4 and the East 10 feet of Lot 5, Block 7, Town of Berthoud, Larimer County, Colorado, as an historical site.

Section 3.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its meeting held this 14th day of December, 1976.

Section 4.

The Board of Trustees of the Town has determined that an emergency condition exists which necessitates the acceptance and application of the aforesaid funds for municipal purposes during the year 1976, thereby necessitating the aforesaid expenditures during 1976, and this Ordinance shall therefor take effect immediately.
