

ORDINANCE NO. 425

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD BY THE ADDITION OF 6.29, DUTY TO MAKE WATER CONNECTIONS BEFORE PAVING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. Purpose:

The Purpose of this Ordinance is to minimize the costs incurred when a connection to an existing water line is made which requires the excavation of an existing street or alley within the Town of Berthoud in order to effect the connection with the Town's water line.

Section 2. Factual Substantiation of Emergency Action:

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud is informed and believes that streets within the limits of the Town will be paved within the next seven (7) days, thereby making the subsequent connections to existing water lines both more expensive and wasteful.

Section 3.

That Chapter 6 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud be amended by the addition of 6.29 to read as follows:

"Before any street or alley in which a water line is laid shall be paved or hardsurfaced, the owners of all lots abutting thereon shall make proper water connection with such water line, whether the immediate use thereof is required or not. Until used, such connecting water tap shall supplied with a proper covering or cap sufficient to prevent the escape of water therefrom."

Section 4.

In the opinion of the Board of the Town of Berthoud, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public health, safety, convenience and general welfare, and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in full force and effect immediately after its final passage and adoption.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, at its meeting held this 12th day of October, 1976.
