

ORDINANCE 422

AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE BUDGET FOR 1976 BE APPROVED BY THE STATE OF COLORADO, DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. The purpose of this Ordinance is to request of the State of Colorado, Department of Local Government, to approve this amendment to the 1976 budget of the Town of Berthoud, Larimer County, Colorado, in order that said budget will conform under law made and provided.

Section 2. In September 1975 when the Town drew up its budget for 1976, it included in the General Fund its Water or Enterprise Fund; estimated its revenue under Street Improvement District No. 68-1 at \$3,500.00, when in fact it should have been \$6,000.00; estimated its revenue under Street Improvement District No. 69-1 at \$9,500.00, when in fact it should have been \$11,500.00; estimated its revenue under Street Improvement District No. 73-1 at \$13,800, when in fact it should have been \$17,800.00; and failed to provide for the Policeman Pension Fund, Cemetery Endowment Fund, and the Garden Fair Escrow Fund.

Section 3. Wherefore, the Town requests this Ordinance amending its 1976 budget be accepted and approved by the State of Colorado, Department of Local Government, to be and read as follows: General Fund - \$225,272.00; Water or Enterprise Fund - \$65,000.00; Street Improvement District No. 68-1 - \$6,000.00; Street Improvement District No. 69-1 - \$11,500.00; Street Improvement District No. 73-1 - \$17,800.00; Policeman Pension Fund - \$4,100.00; Cemetery Endowment Fund - \$3,000.00; Garden Fair Escrow Fund - \$20,000.00.

Section 4. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage, adoption and publication.

This ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its meeting held this 8 day of June, 1976.
