

ORDINANCE NO. 417

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE VACATING OF A PORTION OF 6TH STREET IN THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1: Purpose:

The purpose of this Ordinance is to coordinate and adjust the development of the municipality in accordance with present and future needs and promote the order, convenience, prosperity and general welfare.

Section 2. Vacating Prior Appropriation:

That portion of 6th Street in Rocky Mountain Addition to the Town of Berthoud previously appropriated, which extends South of the South right-of-way line for Bimson Avenue.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its meeting held this 27th day of April, 1976.
