

ORDINANCE NO. 400

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING CHAPTER 17 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, BY ADDING SUBSECTION 17.37, RAILROADS - STREET OBSTRUCTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

That Chapter 17 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado be and the same is hereby modified to incorporate Subsection 17.37 which reads as follows:

17.37 RAILROADS - STREET OBSTRUCTION. It shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct the free passage of any street or public highway within the Town by means of any railroad car, locomotive or other railway vehicle, or to permit the same to remain in or upon any street or public highway across which any railroad may be constructed or operated for a period exceeding five minutes at any one time.

Section 2.

The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety; and whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage and adoption.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its regular meeting held this 10th day of December, 1974.
