

ORDINANCE NO. 553

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17, MUNICIPAL OFFENSES, OF THE BERTHOUD MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD THAT CHAPTER 17 OF THE BERTHOUD MUNICIPAL CODE IS AMENDED WITH THE ADDITION OF THE FOLLOWING SUBSECTION:

CHAPTER 17.

MUNICIPAL OFFENSES

17.24(1) DISORDERLY CONDUCT.

(g) It shall be unlawful for any person to make, continue or cause to be made any noise disturbance, excessive or unusually loud noise or a noise which is unreasonable and objectionable because it is impulsive, continuous, rhythmic, periodic, or shrill within the limits of the Town of Berthoud.

Section 2. Effective Date

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines, and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.

This Ordinance was introduced and read and a public hearing set for March 27, 1984, by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its meeting held this 13th day of March, 1984. After a public hearing, this Ordinance was read, passed, and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 27th day of March, 1984.
