

ORDINANCE NO. 693

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE
OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF THE 1993 BUDGET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR
THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, LARIMER COUNTY,
COLORADO, THAT;

Section 1. WHEREAS, during 1993, the Town of Berthoud determined that the Debt Service Fund did not allocate adequate funds to the operating costs; and

The Board of Trustees, hereby designates \$32,692 of unexpected revenue, be applied to the operating cost for additional bond payments; and

Section 2. WHEREAS, during 1993, the Town of Berthoud determined that the Public Facilities Fund did not allocate adequate funds to the operating cost; and

The Board of Trustees hereby designates \$1,239 of surplus, be applied to the operating cost for the purchase of equipment; and

Section 3. WHEREAS, during 1993, the Town of Berthoud, determined that the Library Fund did not allocate adequate funds to the operating costs; and

The Board of Trustees hereby designates \$13,374 of surplus, be applied to the operating costs for the operation of the Library; and

Section 4. WHEREAS, during 1993, the Town of Berthoud, determined that the Drainage Fund did not allocate adequate funds to the operating costs; and

The Board of Trustees hereby designates \$100 of surplus, be applied to the additional operating costs for refunds on overpaid accounts; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees determines and designates that these expenditures could not have been accurately forecast at the time the 1993 budget was drafted and that these expenditures were necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, which jeopardizes the fiscal welfare of the Town and would affect the health and safety of its citizens. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its final passage and adoption.

At the meeting held on December 14, 1993, the Board of Trustees voted to enact this Ordinance.
