

ORDINANCE NO. 688

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 684 ESTABLISHING
RAW WATER CONTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD,
LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD,
LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 2(a) of Ordinance Number 684 is hereby amended
to read as follows:

Section 2. Evaluation of Usage

(a) Upon the application for either a water tap or building permit, the Town's administrative staff shall determine whether the modifications or proposed use will raise or lower the usage of water on the property by at least one (1) acre foot of water per year. The minimum amount of raw water contribution for any property being served with treated water shall be one (1) acre foot.

Section 2. Section 3(a) of Ordinance Number 684 is hereby amended
to read as follows:

Section 3. Compensation for Raw Water

(a) Prior to the issuance of a water tap or building permit the applicant shall pay a raw water contribution fee of \$2,132.00 for each acre foot of water established in Section 1.

Section 3. Effective Date and Emergency Clause:

The fiscal integrity of the Town of Berthoud and its ability to supply treated water will be jeopardized without immediate implementation of this ordinance and it shall therefor be in effect immediately upon passage by 5 members of the Board of Trustees voting in favor and 1 opposed at the meeting of the Board of Trustees this 11th day of May, 1993.
