

ORDINANCE NO. 639

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURES  
OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF THE 1989 BUDGET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR  
THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, LARIMER, COUNTY,  
COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. WHEREAS, in June 1989, the Town of Berthoud, determined that the correction of the foundation of the northeast corner of the Town Hall, due to settling and equipment maintenance, was necessary; and

WHEREAS, a surplus exists in the amount of funds available for expenditure within the General Fund Capital Improvement, the Board hereby designates \$ 34,000.00 of surplus be applied to the financing of the reconstruction of the foundation of the Town Hall; and

Section 2. WHEREAS, in September 1989, the Town of Berthoud determined that the South Loveland Sanitation District did not allocate adequate funds for the emergency sewer line replacement/street reconstruction.

WHEREAS, a surplus exists in the South Loveland Sanitation District Budget, the Board hereby designates \$ 20,000.00 of the surplus, be applied to the cost of the sewer line replacement/street reconstruction project.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees determines and designates that these expenditures could not have been accurately forecast at the time the Budget was drafted and that these expenditures were necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety.


WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, which jeopardizes the fiscal welfare of the Town and would affect the health and safety of its citizens. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its final passage and adoption.

At the meeting held on December 12, 1989, the Board of Trustees voted to enact this Ordinance.
