

ORDINANCE NO.

607

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 468 OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

WHEREAS pursuant to the Colorado Municipal Election Code of 1965, as amended, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud called and conducted a special election on September 16, 1986; and,

WHEREAS a canvas of the ballots showed that 122 votes were cast in favor of repealing Ordinance 468 and only 90 votes were cast in favor of retaining Ordinance 468;

Section 1.

Ordinance 468 of the Town of Berthoud entitled An Ordinance Restricting The Annexation And Extension Of Utility Services To Outlying Areas By The Town Of Berthoud is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Emergency Clause

The Board of Trustees has determined that the continued presence of Ordinance 468 has an immediate and substantial fiscal impact on both the citizens of the town and the citizens of Larimer County whose real property surrounds the town. The immediate repeal of Ordinance 468 will allow the Board of Trustees to proceed with the resolution of situations within the former South Loveland Sanitation District area which have a continuing impact on the town's ability to process its wastewater.

The Board of Trustees therefore declares that an emergency exists which justifies the immediate repeal of Ordinance 468.

This Ordinance was read in full at its meeting held this 23rd day of September, 1986 and ordered passed by a vote of in favor to a vote of against at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees held the 23rd day of September, 1986.
