

ORDINANCE NO. 767

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DEVELOPMENT CODE FOR THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, STATE OF COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO:

Section 1.

The Town of Berthoud Development Code is hereby amended as follows:

a. **Chapter 30-14 Landscaping Regulations, Section 30-14-303 paragraph "C" shall be and is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:**

"A tree ring shall be maintained around the tree trunks in the tree lawn. The tree ring shall be a minimum of one foot larger than the tree root ball on all sides at the time the tree is planted. Organic mulch shall be installed within the tree ring to ensure that turf, rock mulch, and live plant materials are kept away from the tree on all sides. Maintenance of materials planted within the tree lawn, including the trees, shall be the responsibility of the property owner whose property abuts the tree lawn."

Section 2 Effective Date:

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines, and designates that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.

At its meeting July 8, 1997, a public hearing was set by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud for its meeting held on July 22, 1997. After the public hearing, this Ordinance was read, passed, and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 12th day of August 1997.
