

ORDINANCE NO. 700

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE NUMBER 532 TO ALLOW FOR THE DESIGNATION OF ALTERNATE MEMBERS ON THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND MODIFYING THE TERM OF APPOINTMENT TO NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

Chapter 16 of Ordinance No. 532 is hereby amended to read as follows:

16-1-2 Member of Commission. The Town Planning Commission shall consist of seven (7) members as follows: one member of said commission to be the Mayor; one member to be a Trustee selected by the Mayor; one member to be a Trustee selected by the Board of Trustees; one member to be a Town Administrative official selected by the Mayor; and three members to be appointed by the Board of Trustees. All members of the Commission shall be bona fide residents of the municipality for the entire tenure of their membership on the Planning Commission. The term of each appointed member shall be four years or until his/her successor takes office. The respective terms of the members appointed pursuant to this ordinance shall be fixed and designated by the Board of Trustees at the time of appointment.

Section 2.

Chapter 16 of Ordinance No. 532 is hereby amended by the addition of Section 16-1-9 to read as follows:

16-1-9 Designation of Alternate Members. The Board of Trustees may appoint three (3) alternate members to the Planning and Zoning Commission, one (1) alternate for each of the three (3) members appointed by the Board of Trustees. The Mayor may appoint alternates to serve in the absence of the Trustees and the Town Administrative official. The Mayor Pro Tem shall serve as a member of the Planning and Zoning Commission in the absence of the Mayor.

Section 3. Effective date.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines, and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.

This Ordinance was introduced and read and a public hearing was set for May 24, 1994, by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its meeting held this 10th day of May, 1994. After a public hearing, this Ordinance was read, passed, and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 24th day of May, 1994.
