

ORDINANCE NO. 950

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 940 WHICH IMPOSED A MANDATORY BAN ON THE SALE AND USE OF FIREWORKS AND A BAN ON OPEN BURNING

WHEREAS, the Town of Berthoud, in an effort to ensure consistency of regulations with respect to fires and fireworks, enacted Ordinance No. 940 imposing a ban on the sale or use of fireworks and a ban on open burning; and,

WHEREAS, Larimer and Weld Counties have now repealed their bans on open burning; and,

WHEREAS, changes in weather have lowered the danger of major local wildfire events; and


WHEREAS, the potential for damage to persons and property from fire has decreased.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO THAT ORDINANCE NO. 940 IS REPEALED.

Passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees this 12nd day of November, 2002 by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 opposed.


This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after publication.
