

ORDINANCE NO. 947

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO, ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY MONTHLY SURCHARGE FOR WATER RATES

Section 1.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud has reviewed the existing monthly water rates and has determined that the income to be derived therefrom will be inadequate to pay the bonded indebtedness for the water budget; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 2.

The Board of Trustees has determined it is necessary to impose the following Monthly Base Charge Surcharge to be payable by water consumers located inside or outside the corporate limits of the Town of Berthoud:

Meter Size	Monthly Surcharge
5/8 & 3/4	\$ 38.80
1	\$ 41.50
1 1/2	\$ 46.90
2	\$ 60.10
3	\$ 76.40
4	\$127.90
6	\$195.00

The Surcharge set forth in this Ordinance shall be effective for all October, November and December, 2002 billings.

Section 3. Emergency Clause

The Board of Trustees has determined it is necessary to impose this Surcharge in order to insure enough income to pay the bonded indebtedness for the water budget. An emergency exists justifying the passage of this Ordinance to take effect and be in force immediately upon passage.

At the regular meeting of the board of Trustees, this Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published this 24th day of September, 2002 by a vote of 6 in favor and 0 opposed.
