

ORDINANCE NO. 904

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING THE TRANSFER OF WATER AND WASTEWATER TAPS
SERVED BY THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES,
COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that in order to assist the Town's water and wastewater treatment departments in complying with the rules, regulations and orders of the Environmental Protection Agency and the Colorado Department of Health, limitations need to be placed on the transfer of water and wastewater taps from existing water and wastewater service connections to another property or for another use;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO:

Section 1. Water Tap Transfers.

1. No transfer of an existing water tap which is connected to or will be connected to Berthoud's water treatment system may be made without first obtaining the prior written consent of the Town Administrator.

2. In making this evaluation the Town's staff shall consider whether the transfer of the existing tap to the new location will have a negative impact on the water flows through the Town's water system. If the transfer of the water tap to the new location has the same or less impact on the Town's distribution and treatment system as is generated at the existing location, there shall be a presumption that the transfer of the tap is appropriate.

Section 2. Wastewater Tap Transfers.

1. No transfer of an existing wastewater tap which is connected to or will be connected to Berthoud's wastewater treatment system may be made without first obtaining the prior written consent of the Town Administrator.

2. In making this evaluation the Town's staff shall consider whether the transfer of the existing tap to the new location will negatively impact the wastewater quantity or quality of inflow into the Town's collection system. If the transfer of the wastewater tap to the new location has the same or less impact on the Town's collection and treatment system as the wastewater generated at the existing location, there shall be a presumption that the transfer of the tap is appropriate.

Section 3. Effective Date.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.

At its meeting September 18, 2001, a public hearing was set by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud for its meeting held on the 23rd day of October, 2001. After the public hearing, the Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 23rd day of October, 2001.
