

ORDINANCE NO. 1052

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES,
COLORADO AMENDING ORDINANCE 1046

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD,
LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO:

Section 1. – Section 2 of Ordinance 1046 entitled “Residential Usage Outside of Town” is hereby amended to read:

RESIDENTIAL USAGE OUTSIDE TOWN

5/8 & ¾ Inch Tap – (Rate Table 111)

First 24,000 gallons @ \$5.27 per thousand
Over 24,000 gallons @ \$10.54 per thousand

1-Inch Tap – (Rate Table 112)

First 60,000 gallons @\$5.27 per thousand
Over 60,000 gallons @\$10.54 per thousand

Section 2. Effective Date.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds that the adoption of this ordinance is necessary to provide the funding necessary to maintain the current levels municipal services which are necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Town of Berthoud and that an emergency exists. The fees set forth in this ordinance shall take effect with the March, 2007 billing cycle.

A public hearing was set for its meeting held on the 27th day of February 2007. At the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees, this ordinance was read, passed and ordered published this 27th day of February 2007 by a vote of 6 in favor and 0 opposed.
