**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO
WAIVING CERTAIN LIQUOR LICENSE RENEWAL FEES**

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has caused economic stress on local businesses, including those that hold a liquor license from the State of Colorado and which were mandated to cease regular business operations for a time in 2020 due to the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on December 7, 2020, Governor Polis signed Senate Bill 20B-001 into law, providing economic assistance to certain on-premises liquor licensees and the State of Colorado's Liquor Enforcement Division subsequently authorized waiving renewal fees from December 7, 2020 – December 7, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Liquor Code provides for the establishment of local application fees and permit fees by the local licensing authorities; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, Municipal Code authorizes the Board of Trustees to establish or waive fees by Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, that annual Liquor License Renewal Fees pursuant to Subsection 14.1-3 of the Berthoud Municipal Code will be waived for 2021 for all On-Premises Consumption.
