RESOLUTION NO. 25

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, APPROVING A COORDINATED MAIL BALLOT ELECTION AND ADOPTING THE UNIFORM ELECTION CODE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Berthoud is subject to the Colorado Municipal Election Code, Article 1 of Title 31, C.R.S. but may choose to conduct elections pursuant to the Uniform Election Code, Article 1 of Title 1, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Town Board of the Town of Berthoud to coordinate with the Counties of Larimer and Weld for the November 6, 2018 Election and to adopt the provisions of the Uniform Election Code to govern the conduct of such election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, THAT:

1. The Berthoud Town Board incorporates the foregoing recitals as its conclusions, facts, determinations, and findings.
2. The Town Board hereby authorizes Town staff to coordinate with the Counties of Weld and Larimer for the November 6, 2018 General Election.
3. The Town Board hereby appoints the Town Clerk to serve as Designated Election Official.
4. For the municipal election of November 8, 2018, the Town hereby adopts the Uniform Election Code, Article 1 of Title 1, C.R.S.
5. The Town Board hereby approves the Intergovernmental Agreements with the Counties of Larimer and Weld regarding the conduct of the 2018 coordinated mail ballot election in the form submitted, ratifies any prior approval of such agreements, and authorizes the Town Administrator to execute such agreements. A copy of each Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A and Exhibit B.
