

RESOLUTION NO. 8-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, SUBMITTING TO THE REGISTERED ELECTORS VOTING IN THE GENERAL COORDINATED ELECTION TO BE HELD NOVEMBER 7, 2017, A BALLOT ISSUE CONCERNING WHETHER THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD SHOULD IMPOSE AN EXCISE TAX ON THE SALE OF MARIJUANA AND MARIJUANA PRODUCTS SOLD AT RETAIL WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN:

WHEREAS, the Town of Berthoud, Colorado ("Town"), is a statutory town; and

WHEREAS, the Town is considering the possibility of allowing the retail sale of Marijuana and Cannabis products within the confines of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town will incur costs associated with such retail sales, if it is approved, and the contribution of such a business to the revenues if the Town is one important consideration in determining if it should be allowed; and

WHEREAS, regular sales taxes are inadequate to address both the additional law enforcement, regulatory, and administrative burdens which might arise from retail sales and to provide general revenue to the Town; and

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 20, of the Colorado Constitution ("TABOR Amendment") limits the ability of the Town to impose such a sales and excise tax without a vote of the electorate; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud desires to capture sales taxes for recreational marijuana sales which have been and will continue flowing to surrounding jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the TABOR Amendment permits electors of the Town to approve the imposition of such taxes and to authorize the expenditure of revenues from such taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds and determines that it is necessary and desirable to submit to the electors of the Town voting at the General Coordinated Election to be held on November 7, 2017, the question of enacting a sales and excise tax on the sale of marijuana and marijuana products.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Clerk on or before 5:00 PM, on September 22, 2017, and that a summary of such comments will be distributed to registered voters in accordance with law.

Section 5. The officers and employees of the Town are hereby authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution.


