

**TOWN OF BERTHOUD
RESOLUTION NO. 29-16**

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF JOHN EASLEY AS
BERTHOUD MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE AND APPOINTING STEWART OLIVE AS
MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2017, AND CONTINUING
THROUGH APRIL, 2016.**

WHEREAS, the board of trustees, of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado (the "Town") previously appointed John Easley as its Municipal Court Judge;

WHEREAS, Judge Easley tendered his notice of resignation on June 27, 2016;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Colorado Revised Statutes, Title 13, as well as the Berthoud Municipal Code, at Chapters 3 and 9, the Town is authorized to operate a municipal court for the enforcement of its duly adopted codes, ordinances and regulations and as part of that function to appoint qualified persons to serve the Town as its Municipal Court Judge; and,


WHEREAS, the Town is prepared to exercise its authority and to appoint a new judge to serve the balance of Judge John Easley's term.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

That Stewart Olive is appointed to serve as Municipal Judge and shall be compensated by the Town pursuant to CRS 13-10-105 and BMC Chapter 3.5.
