A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO REGARDING COOPERATON FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF STATE AND FEDERAL IMMIGRATION LAWS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO THAT:

In compliance with §29-29-103, *C.R.S.*, the peace officers of the Town of Berthoud are hereby directed to cooperate with State and Federal officials with regard to enforcement of State and Federal laws regarding immigration. A peace officer who has probable cause to believe that an arrestee for a criminal offense is not legally present in the United States shall report such arrestee to the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement Office if the arrestee is not held at a detention facility.

The Board of Trustees further directs the staff of the Town of Berthoud to provide written confirmation of this resolution to the General Assembly and to annually, on or before March 1 of each year, report to the legislative counsel of the Colorado General Assembly the number of reports made to the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement Office.

This resolution was read and passed by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 opposed at the meeting of the Board of Trustees on the 25th day of July, 2006.
