## **RESOLUTION NO. 1-05**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO TO NAME THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AFTER TOM JONES.

WHEREAS, Tom Jones operated a plumbing and heating business in Berthoud for forty-five years and installed, repaired and maintained the vast majority of the Town's public water and wastewater infrastructure; and,

WHEREAS, Tom Jones served as a Trustee for the Town for four years and on the Town's Planning and Zoning Commission for eight years; and,

WHEREAS, Tom Jones was a twenty-one year member of the Berthoud Fire Department; and,

WHEREAS, Tom Jones was active in the 4-H clubs in the area and used his equipment in transporting their floats to and from various parades in Colorado; and,

WHEREAS, Tom Jones constructed the fence for the Town's first baseball diamond; and,

WHEREAS, Tom Jones volunteered his time and equipment for use by the Berthoud Library and Museum; and,

WHEREAS, Tom Jones used his equipment to install the announcers' booth at the Berthoud High School athletic field; and,

WHEREAS, Tom Jones constructed a dance hall above his business for square dancing and other Town uses;

WHEREAS, Tom Jones donated his machinery and labor for the plumbing and heating at the museum; and,

WHEREAS, the Town desires to recognize the many years of dedicated public service by Tom Jones to the Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO THAT:

The Town's wastewater treatment plant shall be named The Town of Berthoud Tom Jones Wastewater Treatment Facility.

This resolution was passed by a unanimous vote at the meeting of the Board of Trustees on the  $22^{nd}$  day of March, 2005.
