

RESOLUTION NO. 23-01

A RESOLUTION LIMITING THE TRANSFER OF WASTEWATER TAPS SERVED BY THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that in order to assist the Town's wastewater treatment department in complying with the rules, regulations and orders of the Environmental Protection Agency and the Colorado Department of Health, limitations need to be placed on the transfer of wastewater taps from an existing wastewater service connection to another property or for another use;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO THAT:

1. No transfer of an existing wastewater tap which is connected to or will be connected to Berthoud's wastewater treatment system may be made without first obtaining the prior written consent of the Town Administrator or the Wastewater Superintendent.

2. In making this evaluation the Town's staff shall consider whether the transfer of the existing tap to the new location will negatively impact the wastewater inflow into the Town's collection system at the new location. If the transfer of the wastewater tap to the new location has the same or less impact on the Town's collection and treatment system as the wastewater generated at the existing location, there shall be a presumption that the transfer of the tap is appropriate.

This resolution was introduced, read and passed at the special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud on September 18, 2001 by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 opposed.
