

RESOLUTION NO. 36-00

A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE BERTHOUD AND LOVELAND COMMUNITY SEPARATOR PLAN.

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud are charged with the responsibility of implementing master planning documents for the Town of Berthoud; and,

WHEREAS, the Berthoud and Loveland Community Separator Plan provides for a desirable method of achieving a rural separation between the Town of Berthoud and the City of Loveland; and,

WHEREAS, the Berthoud and Loveland Community Separator Plan is subservient to the Town of Berthoud Land Use Plan;

WHEREAS, the Berthoud Planning Commission adopted the Berthoud and Loveland Separator Plan at its meeting on November 30, 2000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO:

1. Exhibit 1 entitled "Berthoud & Loveland Community Separator Plan" dated November 6, 2000 and the accompanying maps contained therein are hereby adopted in order to help guide the separator effort in a manner subservient to the Town of Berthoud Land Use Plan.

This resolution was passed by a vote of 6 in favor and 1 opposed at the meeting of the Town Board on the 12th day of December, 2000.
