

RESOLUTION NO. 17-00

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$200,000 IN 2001 AND 2002 FOR THE PURCHASE OF CONSERVATION EASEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Larimer and Weld Counties, Colorado, has determined that it is in the best interests of the Town to maintain agricultural areas between Weld County Road 3 and Weld County Road 7; and,

WHEREAS, the draft 2000 Land Use Plan Update designates the area between Weld County Road 3 and Weld County Road 7 as agricultural preservation areas; and,

WHEREAS, the purchase of conservation easements is an integral step toward preservation of agriculture in this area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Larimer and Weld Counties, Colorado, that:

1. The Town of Berthoud hereby commits to funding \$100,000 in its 2001 fiscal budget and \$100,000 in its 2002 fiscal budget for the purpose of purchasing conservation easements on one or more properties located along the Highway 56 corridor and the Little Thompson River corridor, between Weld County Road 3 and Weld County Road 7, in order to comply with the Town's Land Use Plan.

This Resolution was read, and after public input, passed by a vote of 6 in favor and 1 opposed at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees on September 12, 2000.

The Town of Berthoud hereby commits to funding \$100,000 in its 2001 fiscal budget and \$100,000 in its 2002 fiscal budget for the purpose of purchasing conservation easements on the Hofmeister property which is a portion of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 16, Township 4 North, Range 68 West of the 6th P.M., Weld County, Colorado and the Rockwell property which is a portion of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 29, Township 4 North, Range 68 West of the 6th P.M., Weld County, Colorado in order to comply with the Town's Land Use Plan.

This Resolution was read, and after public input, passed by a vote of 6 in favor and 1 opposed at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees on September 12, 2000.
