

RESOLUTION NO. 9-98

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE PROPOSED MILL LEVY FOR THE BERTHOUD FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, Berthoud has been professionally provided with fire protection and emergency medical services by the Berthoud Fire Protection District; and,

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Berthoud and their property are dependent upon the continued expansion of the capital facilities of the fire department including the replacement of a fire truck which is 22 years old and the future construction of a second fire station. This will result in a reduction of homeowner's fire insurance premiums because of reduced response times; and,

WHEREAS, the mill levy is a continuation of an existing tax which will impose a \$21.75 tax on a \$175,000 home;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER AND WELD COUNTIES, COLORADO:

The Board of Trustees hereby resolves to support the Berthoud Fire Protection District and encourages the citizens of Berthoud to vote in favor of question A at the election on May 5, 1998 to be held at the Berthoud Area Community Center.

This resolution was read and approved by a vote of 5 in favor and -0- opposed at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees on the 28th day of April, 1998.
