

Berthoud's New Ultrasonic Buoy Needs a Name

Berthoud has a new buoy in need of a name. With the help of a grant from the American Rescue Plan Act and Larimer County, the Town purchased an LG ultrasonic buoy to help control algae growth in our reservoir. As many of you know, Berthoud Reservoir is divided into two sides. The west side is where people enjoy walks, fishing, and paddle boarding. The east side, however, holds the water that will eventually make its way to our homes.

Launched in June, the solar-powered buoy eliminates up to 95% of existing algae and predicts new blooms before they start, thereby significantly improving our overall water quality. Using ultrasonic waves that do not hurt fish, bugs, or people, it floats there all day, working hard to clean our water – so we think it deserves a name. Kids, we need your help. What should we call it? Put on your thinking caps and send us your most creative ideas. The winner, chosen by popular vote, will be invited to join the Town Council meeting where the buoy's name will become official by Town Decree. A plaque with its new name will be hung on the fence surrounding the reservoir, and the winner's picture will appear in a future issue of InFocus.

The Town is accepting name suggestions until August 20 online at Berthoud.org. Then, ten finalists will be chosen and listed for voting on the Town's website and our Facebook page. Voting will end on August 27, and the winner will be announced in the October issue of InFocus. **Learn more at Berthoud.org.**

This building was initially built as a horse stable but quickly converted into a garage for automobiles and later into a restaurant and store.
