## Town Christmas Tree Recycling

Give your tree another life after Christmas. Recycling your tree is better for the planet and for our community. Once again, the Town of Berthoud will be hosting a Christmas tree recycling drop-off site. **The convenient drop-off service will begin Monday, December 27, and run through Saturday, January 8.** The drop site will be located at the Town Parks and Forestry building, at 100 10th Street.

### Holiday tree drop off dates and hours:

- 7:00 am – 3:30 pm weekdays, beginning December 27
- Open Saturday, January 8, from 9:00 am – 1:00 pm.
- CLOSED Saturday, January 1 for New Year's Day
- CLOSED Sundays

**Please do not leave your trees at the closed gate during hours that the center is not open to accept your tree.** Violators will be caught on camera and will receive a fine. Residents are asked to please check-in with staff before when dropping off their trees. Please make sure you remove all lights and decorations before drop off, or your trees will not be accepted.

**Artificial trees are not accepted at this drop-off.** Artificial trees, in good condition, can be donated to a second-hand store or area non-profit. For program questions, please call 970-532-4256.

## TOWN PROJECT UPDATES

### 1st Street Roundabout Renovations

The first phase of improvements at the 1st St. roundabout has been completed. Inspired by the "Prairie to Mountains" theme, the design includes stamped concrete bricks that outline newly raised medians, while boulders and flagstone add mountain accents and dimension to the final look. In addition, at our Town's east side entrance, an assortment of colorful perennial plantings will be installed in the Spring of 2022 to promote Berthoud's Garden Spot nickname.

### Skate Park at Waggener Farm Park

The new Waggener Farm Skatepark is now open! This state-of-the-art 11,000 sq.ft. park was built and designed by the American Ramp Company and Pivot Custom Designs teams. The park features an amazing medium-sized flow bowl complete with a spine, a boulder, and a unique high-wall "tombstone" extension. There is also a street section with multiple ledges, hubba, stairs, handrail, euro gap, and a pole jam.
