

Water Treatment Plant Improvements

On February 10, 2022, sealed bids were received, opened, and read publicly at Town Hall for the latest capital construction project at the Water Treatment Plant (WTP). The WTP was originally constructed in 1933 and improvements we made in 1996, 2002, and 2013. The new WTP proposed improvements will focus on strengthening the existing processes rather than expanding the plant's capacity. The primary focus of the work is to enhance the ability of the plant to blend and treat water from the Berthoud Reservoir, which is right next door. **A new blending facility will be constructed to the north of the existing pretreatment building.** This facility will allow operators to measure and adjust raw water flow from various sources. Complimentary of these improvements, a powdered activated carbon (PAC) feed system will be installed. The PAC system will help control the taste and odor of the finished treated water. Lastly, the plant's filters will be improved with a new system for supplying backwash water. The WTP's iconic steel four-legged water tower will be rehabilitated and painted as part of these improvements.

The apparent low bidder is Asian Construction, a local general contractor headquartered in Berthoud that specializing in municipal water projects.


Berthoud Parkway Trail Connections

The South Berthoud Parkway Trail Gap project was completed in early January 2022. Over 2,000 feet of regional trail was installed along South Berthoud Parkway between Spartan Avenue and Welch Avenue. The project was partially funded with a grant of \$200,000 obtained through the North Front Range Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). This summer, the Rose Farm Acres Development is expected to complete the remaining trail gap to Blue Bell Road.

The South trail will continue north along the Waggener Farm Park and Vantage Development. The North section will include an enhanced bike and pedestrian crossing at the intersection of Water Ave and Berthoud Parkway, a 10-foot wide regional trail separated from the roadway that extends north to County Road 10E, where a completed trail system already exists. In addition to the crosswalk and trail, a 6 to 8 foot wide bike and pedestrian pathway will be added to the existing bridge on County Road 10E over Highway 287. Jersey barriers will protect the new path from road traffic.

The Town was recently awarded a \$500,000 grant through the State's "Revitalizing Main Streets Program," which will go towards constructing this project. In addition, this section of the trail is covered in the most recently updated Trails Master Plan.
