Recreation Center Design Award

Our Recreation Center architect, Barker Rinker Seacat Architecture submitted the Berthoud Recreation Center at Waggener Farm Park for this year's CPRA's (Colorado Parks & Recreation Association) Columbine Awards. **The Town was recently notified that it won the best new design facility!**

The Colorado Parks & Recreation Association Awards Program is designed to recognize and celebrate the individuals and organizations contributing to the success and value of parks and recreation in Colorado. Designed to bring attention to its recipients, the award highlights the achievements of association members and community champions. The Award is divided into three categories, Design, Innovation, and Programming and our facility was submitted for 'Design'. The award was open to new or renovated park or recreation facility projects. Town Administrators, the Recreation Department, and BRS will be accepting the award at the Colorado Park & Recreation annual conference on Thursday, October 6, 2022, located in Breckenridge.

Updates: Berthoud Recreation Department

The Colorado Department of Local Affairs (DOLA), in collaboration with the Office of Economic Development and International Trade (OEDIT), has created the Pools Special Initiative 2022 for local governments. This new initiative supports the operations of public swimming pools across the state for the 2022 summer season. This one-time grant program intends to provide incentives to attract and retain public swimming pool employees and incentivize them to stay through the summer to ensure adequate staffing levels that allows swimming pools to be open at maximum capacity.

The Town of Berthoud applied for this special grant and was successful! We received \$12,500 for our aquatics department. The grant is divided into two payouts in the amount of \$6,250.00. The first payout was identified to support the retention of current employees based on longevity and hours worked, as well as those who worked from May 1, 2022, to July 31, 2022.

The second payout was identified to support retention and recruitment. Employees who stayed and worked from August 1, 2022, to September 30, 2022, and based on hours worked through a tiered hours tracking program, have additional bonus pay. The Recreation Department has also allocated funds for sign-on bonuses for an Aquatics Specialist lifeguards, and head guard positions.
