

- ii. Property is used to train retrievers as well as farming hay. Retriever training uses ponds on the property for training.
- iii. There is future potential or trails, public use and agriculture
- iv. If open to the public, will need restrooms, protection for existing buildings on the property which are currently used for storage. There would likely be a reservation system with a reservation fee to cover costs associated with locking/unlocking property.

B. Cedar Dr. Median Landscape Conversion – Derek McMartin, Parks Supervisor (30 mins)

- i. Water Wise Conversion: converting from high water use to low water use landscaping
- ii. We have received a 50% match grant from Northern Water
- iii. Using ornamental beds, native plants, possibly a trail in the middle of the median.
- iv. Phase I will be scraping the existing vegetation, planting ornamental grasses and updating/repairing irrigation which would take 2 summer seasons to allow grasses to take root
- v. Phase II: planting vegetation, bushes
- vi. Plan in collaboration with Denver Botanical Gardens
- vii. Public comment: Concern regarding communication with neighborhood residents. Petition signed by 20 residents to rethink the plan. Concern for trash building up in the vegetation, creating a snow wall along Cedar Dr., concern for the available sidewalks along Cedar Dr. Also, heard a letter of support from a resident of Cedar Dr. sighting the need for xeriscaping and updating
- viii. PORT committee members voiced agreement with plan to move forward
