A. Berthoud Unified Trail Master Plan: Updates, Scope of Work, Discussion – Keith Knoll

- Update of the parks master plans from 2018

- Town is wanting to interview PORT Committee members individually for input including consulting with neighboring towns. Stakeholder questions provided.
- Scope of Work outlined through the end of the year with the goal of approval in February
 - Using Central City Master Plan
 - PORT Members suggest prioritized action items for Berthoud Master Plan
 - Soft shoulders for regional trails, ideal for neighborhood trails
 - Sidewalks being considered as a part of connection to trails/identify as such on Trails map
 - Patrol of trails to address possible people experiencing homelessness
- Grants
 - South Berthoud Pkwy Grant to close gap between Spartan Rose Farms to be completed this year, hopefully by November
 - \$500,000 Grant for the North/South Trail awarded

B. Richardson Park: Bike Park Amenity – Keith Knoll

Regional amenity to draw people to Berthoud

Bmx bike park zoned for a portion of the Richardson Park Plan

Survey feedback: Many people wanted beginner to advanced options

Bike survey results- input from community riders and local bike clubs

PORT suggestions and Questions-

- Centrally located restroom facilities to anticipate building the Richardson plan? Long-term planning: Ball fields project? Outdoor pool?
- Plan for the entire vision for Richardson and not as separate projects
- Asphalt vs dirt for pumptrack?
 - Bikes only-dirt Asphalt- other wheeled toys
- Centrally located restroom facilities to anticipate building the Richardson plan? Long-term planning: Ball fields project? Outdoor pool?
- Theme suggestions: no specific suggestions, but PORT questions the wear and tear on design elements. Also, keeping the theme related items to the elements for younger riders.
 - RFP in the works for Richardson that will include the bikepark
