The meeting of the Berthoud Youth Advisory Commission was called to order on Wednesday, January 26th, 2022 at 8:19 a.m. by the Chair, Grazia Novak. Members Grazia Novak, Daniel Hatton, Kenyan Clarkson and liaison Maureen Dower were in attendance. This was a meeting between the BYAC and members from the recreation department.

2. Discussion with Rec Center staff

a. Carnival Plans

A discussion took place about the BYAC's goals for the carnival. It is meant to be an event geared towards teens in Berthoud. The town fully expects to lose money the first year of this event. There was discussion about whether the carnival would be over in one or two days. Two days would allow more people to come to the event, but would cost a lot more. The rec center staff recommended one day unless there is room in the budget. They then discussed what people would be charged to ride the rides, and whether they would pay for entry or per ride. A per ride cost would lower lines but would need fast rides. The carnival is planned for near the end of July, where it doesn't conflict with many other big days. Volunteers for the event could be found from the high school, such as the football team. Finding sponsors for the event would allow us to add more things such as food trucks. Marketing for the carnival can be done at previous town events, It was estimated that 60% of high school and middle school students would show up to this event. It was agreed that more research was needed on the vendor's policy and the need for a clear budget. The Commission agreed to discuss this during our regular February 3 meeting.

b. Snow fest ice rink

A snow fest ice rink was not discussed in detail, other than that an ice rink would be very expensive and hard to actually have.

c. Future events

The commission stated their interest in continuing their trash clean up day, dodgeball tournament on July 3rd, and cornhole during Oktoberfest.
