2. Review previous meetings minutes, vote to confirm

All members will work to spread word of the event on social media. The plan moving forward for the banners will be discussed at the next meeting.
 - ii. Split up who will find what
The commission found items to buy online and made a list with the links to send to Amanda. Angie plans on bringing an attendance counter. Everyone can bring their own chairs, and volunteers can bring tables. It was also discussed that it would be good to bring a box of snacks like chips for the volunteers.
 - e. Volunteer game plan
The commission discussed getting more people who may be interested in volunteering to actually sign up on the sign up genius. It was also decided that a link for volunteers in our Instagram bio would help.
