Prevent West Nile Virus with The 4 Ds:

Drain: Drain any standing water in your yard each week. Bird baths, clogged gutters and kiddie pools are common breeding sites.

Defend: Apply insect repellent sparingly to exposed skin. Use an approved repellent according to its label.

Dress: Wear lightweight, long-sleeved shirts and long pants while outdoors. Spray clothing with insect repellent.

Dawn/ Dusk: Stay indoors around dawn and dusk. These are peak mosquito biting hours.

Due to a warm, wet spring, there will be many, many, many mosquitos this summer. Since it's impossible to know which mosquitos carry West Nile Virus and which don't, it is essential to check your property for standing water to help keep their numbers down as much as possible. The inside of tires, empty flower pots, and bird baths are some of the most common mosquito breeding grounds.

To protect yourself and the people you care about from West Nile Virus, remember the Four Ds:

DRAIN standing water,

DRESS in light-colored, long sleeve shirts and pants,


DEFEND by wearing insect repellent,

and at DAWN or DUSK, stay indoors when possible.

Golf Cart/LEV/UTV Rules of the Road



One of the things that makes Berthoud unique is the ability to scoot around town in a golf cart. If you choose to drive a golf cart or UTV in town, remember that you must not only follow traffic laws, but also Berthoud's municipal code on Golf Cart/LEV/UTV usage. Follow the tips below to make Berthoud safe for everyone on the road.

If you are driving a golf cart, LEV or UTV:

- The driver must have a valid driver's license.
- Vehicles may not exceed 25 mph.
- These vehicles shall not carry a greater number of persons than that specified by the manufacturer. (One person per seat.)
- UTVs must be titled and registered as a Class C vehicle and be plated with license plates and current tags.
- The proper "slow moving vehicle" reflective placard must be attached to the back of golf carts.
- It is illegal to drive on state highways with any of these vehicles. (This includes US 287 and Mountain Avenue/ CO Hwy 56).
- Golf carts may not be driven on sidewalks, on most trails and paths, or in bike lanes.
