Berthoud Bike Park Opens

Mother Nature may have rained on our plans to hold a grand opening for the Berthoud Bike Park, but she couldn't dampen the enthusiasm you've all had for the gates to be open. The 20-acre park located at 1223 Meadowlark Dr, features extensive jump lines, a mountain bike trail, and a competition-sized asphalt pump park that has already proven to be a fan favorite with area riders. There is also a bicycle playground for small children just learning to ride. The Town's Forestry and Parks staff are now planning for trees, landscaping, and shaded areas to make it even better.

Though construction began in March of this year, the idea for the bike park was first introduced in 2018 when the Parks, Open Space, Recreation and Trails committee included it in the Berthoud Master Plan Summary. The master plan contains concepts for other proposed projects around Berthoud, including phase two of this park, which is slated to include a destination aquatics area, a large playground, and multiple ball fields.

Roundabouts at I-25 and HWY 56

Work is about to start on the roundabouts on both sides of I-25. When finished, the roundabouts on the east and west sides of I-25 will be landscaped and fitted with sculpture artwork titled "Berthoud Bouquet" by Tim Upham. Look for that work to start this month.

Meet the Team: Greenlawn Cemetery



Though the first recorded burial at Berthoud's Greenlawn Cemetery was in 1884, the very first deeded plot was purchased by Mr. J.P. Barnhart on October 19, 1886, for \$10. Since then, the cemetery has remained a serene place where families can inter, visit, and remember their loved ones.

Two people comprise the team that takes care of this important Town amenity. Wende Moore, Lead Administrative Technician, has been with the Town of Berthoud since 2021. While Wende is responsible for processing passport applications, utility payments, and business licensing, she also handles administrative duties related to the Greenlawn Cemetery, including guiding lot selection, columbarium, memorials, and other burial matters. This often involves the delicate matter of coordinating with funeral homes and grieving families.

Sam Pickard, who has been with the Town since 2022, is the Cemetery Maintenance Technician responsible for its general upkeep. This work includes care of the cemetery grounds, irrigation, access roads, and fencing. Sam, with support from the Town's Streets department, is also responsible for locating burial plots and preparing them for interment.

The Greenlawn Cemetery team provides a necessary service to the community, and they strive to offer compassionate and thoughtful assistance through one of the most difficult times in someone's life.
