## Meet Walt Elish, Berthoud's Economic Development Manager

Walt Elish has been the Town's Economic Development Manager for nine years. He's seen Berthoud grow and our downtown flourish in that time. He's shared some highlights from 2023 and a look into our future.

Berthoud welcomed about **a dozen new businesses** to the community in 2023. By choosing Berthoud, they provide job opportunities for our residents and enhance our quality of life.

We held the **Holiday Shop Local Program**. In its second year, this popular program incentivizes people to spend money in our local shops and restaurants by having weekly drawings for \$75 gift cards to Berthoud businesses. The goal of this program is for people to not only shop locally when possible but also explore a business they may have overlooked in the past.

**Downtown Development Authority (DDA):** Working with businesses in the downtown area, we are exploring the possibility of creating a DDA in Berthoud. A DDA aims to ensure that the Town and these businesses work together to enhance our downtown core through infrastructure improvements, event planning, and promoting/administering new development opportunities. All of this contributes to a robust local economy.

**Berthoud Broadband Infrastructure:** The Town Board approved the Business Development Department's recommendation to partner with Hilltop Broadband to bring fast, reliable, and affordable internet service to every Berthoud household. Project implementation will begin in 2024.


