Carter Lake Pipeline

The Town of Berthoud is committed to maintaining a reliable and high-quality water supply for our community. As part of this effort, we are making key improvements to the Carter Lake Pipeline, a critical source of raw water for our Water Treatment Plant. This project includes replacing aging infrastructure, installing new high-capacity pipeline sections, and upgrading pump stations and valves to enhance efficiency and reliability. These improvements will expand our water transmission capacity, reduce the risk of supply interruptions, and support future growth. During construction, you may notice a change in the taste of your water as we temporarily rely on different water sources to maintain service. While the taste may vary, please rest assured that the Town continuously monitors and tests the water to ensure it meets all state and federal safety standards. Recent rate increases have made these essential upgrades possible, ensuring we can continue delivering safe, consistent, and high-quality drinking water. We appreciate your support and patience as we invest in Berthoud's water future.

North Berthoud Parkway Trail Connection

What's happening on the west side of North Berthoud Parkway? We're closing the gap on the North Berthoud Parkway Trail. Paid for in part by a \$500,000 grant through the Revitalizing Main Street Program, the new portion of trail will extend from Water Avenue up to County Road 10E and include a pedestrian crossing from Water Avenue to the trail. We are expecting to finish up by late spring. (Weather permitting, of course.)
