West Nile Virus

Mosquitos testing positive for West Nile Virus have been found in traps around Berthoud. The Vector Index (VI) for the week of July 16th was 1.01, which indicates that many mosquitoes in our area are infected. While the Town does not regularly spray for mosquitoes, larvicide efforts are ongoing and do occur regularly. Larvicide helps reduce adult mosquito populations by targeting mosquito larvae in their breeding habitat before they can mature into adult mosquitoes and disperse.
