## Town of Berthoud Launches Interactive Development Activity Map

**Berthoud, CO (October 16, 2025):** The Town of Berthoud's Community Development Department has launched a new interactive development activity map designed to enhance transparency and public access to information about ongoing and proposed development projects within the community.

The new online tool provides residents, business owners, and developers with a real-time view of development activities across Berthoud. Users can easily navigate the map to see projects that are in development review, denied, approved, or under construction. Each category can be filtered on the left-hand side of the screen, allowing users to focus on specific phases of development. Clicking on an individual project icon provides additional information and context about that particular development.

“This new tool is map-based and is an accessible, interactive way to stay informed about growth and development in Berthoud,” said Community Development Director Anne Johnson. “It supports our commitment to transparency and helps residents understand where new development is occurring and how each project aligns with the Town’s long-term vision.”

The Community Development Department plays a key role in guiding developers and builders to ensure all projects align with the Town’s Comprehensive Plan, Development Code, and master

plans and overlay districts. The review process involves close collaboration between several Town departments, including Water/Wastewater, Public Works, Engineering, and Parks and Recreation, as well as with outside referral agencies such as the Berthoud Fire Protection District, Thompson School District, Berthoud Community Library District, CDOT, and Larimer and Weld Counties.

This cross-departmental and multi-agency collaboration ensures that development in Berthoud reflects community values, meets safety and design standards, and supports sustainable growth.
